All-loving God, we give you thanks and praise for mothers young and old.....

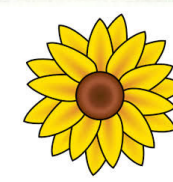
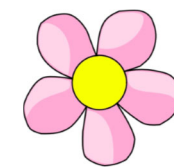
We pray for young mothers who give life and count toes and tend to our every need; May they be blessed with patience and tenderness to care for their families and themselves with great joy.

We pray for our own mothers who have nurtured and cared for us; May they continue to guide us in strong and gentle ways.

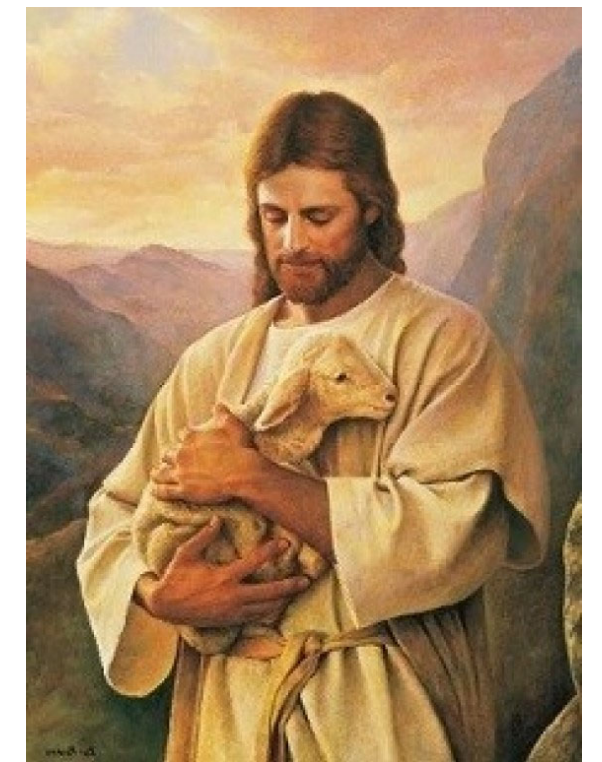
We remember mothers who are separated from their children because of war, poverty, or conflict; May they feel the loving embrace of our God who wipes every tear away.

## Gospel for Fourth Sunday of Easter



Jesus said: "My sheep hear my voice; I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish. No one can take them out of my hand. My Father, who has given them to me, is greater than all, and no one can take them out of the Father's hand. The Father and I are one." [John 10:27-30]

### Here are two simple ways we can honor Mary, Mother of God, and our Mother too, this Mother's Day:

1. Pray the Rosary. Take a few moments, either alone or with your family, to pray the Rosary.
2. Bring Mary Flowers. During May (the month of Mary), it is customary to set up an extra-special space in your home to honor Our Lady. A Mary altar doesn't have to be fancy. If you don't have a statue of Mary, a holy card and Rosary can adorn your altar.
