New Mass Schedule beginning Monday, 7/27/20

Beginning Monday, July 27, the following Masses at Blessed Sacrament will be cancelled:

- 8:30 AM daily Mass [Monday through Friday]
- 10:30 AM Sunday Mass
- 12:00 PM First Friday Mass [Latin]
- 9:00 AM First Saturday Mass [Latin]

The following Masses at Blessed Sacrament will continue until further notice:

- 4:00 PM Saturday Vigil Mass [English]
- 8:30 AM Sunday Mass [Latin]
- 12:10 PM Sunday Mass [Spanish]

Daily Masses will be at Little Flower (Monday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, and Saturday) at 8:15am and (most) Tuesdays at 5:30pm (Extraordinary Form/EF). Any changes/cancellations to the Tuesday Mass will be in the bulletin. The First Friday EF Mass will be at 6pm and the First Saturday EF Mass will at 8:15am. These two Masses will now be at Little Flower. More will be communicated in the future with regard to these. Confessions will also be heard with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament at Little Flower every Thursday from 5-7pm. Benediction will be at 7pm.

Message from Bishop Talley

The dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation presently in effect continues through the 4th of September. In particular, those who are experiencing any sickness, those with any health vulnerability and those fearful of the possible infection of COVID 19 should stay at home.

Guidelines for attending Mass

- No social gathering before OR after Mass
- Must wear a facial mask while in the Church
- Communion "in the hand" recommended
- Continuation of the 6-foot social distance rule
- Every other pew blocked off
- Cry room to remain closed
- Collection baskets will be located near both doors
- Use hand sanitizer before entering the Church
- Stay home if you are ill or have any medical issues
- No non-liturgical meetings in excess of 50 people

Mass Requests

During the transition of Pastors, we are uncertain regarding Blessed Sacrament's Mass schedule in August and thereafter. Therefore, we will not be taking Mass requests for the time being.

No farewell reception -

a "FAREWELL BASKET" instead

Due to the rising number of covid-19 cases in Shelby County, it would not be prudent/safe to invite hundreds of parishioners to a farewell reception for Fr. Fisher in the small gymnasium. Bishop Talley addressed this issue in his most recent decree: "... there are to be no social gatherings in the parish of more than fifty people in any one room or enclosed space, through the 31st of July."

So, instead of a reception, a "FAREWELL BASKET" will be placed in the rear of the church (near the Infant Jesus statue) for parishioners to leave Fr. Ed a farewell card and wish him 'fair winds and following seas' in his new assignment. We thank him for his example and teaching and faithfulness during the last nine years. We will miss him. The Gospel for the 15th Sunday in OT



On that day, Jesus went out of the house and sat down by the sea. Such large crowds gathered around him that he got into a boat and sat down, and the whole crowd stood along the shore. And he spoke to them at length in parables, saying: "A sower went out to sow. And as he sowed, some seed fell on the path, and birds came and ate it up. Some fell on rocky ground, where it had

little soil. It sprang up at once because the soil was not deep, and when the sun rose it was scorched, and it withered for lack of roots. Some seed fell among thorns, and the thorns grew up and choked it. But some seed fell on rich soil and produced fruit, a hundred or sixty or thirtyfold. Whoever has ears ought to hear."
