The Gospel for the 22nd Sunday in OT



Jesus began to show his disciples that he must go to Jerusalem and suffer greatly from the elders, the chief priests, and the scribes, and be killed and on the third day be raised. Then Peter took Jesus aside and began to rebuke him, "God forbid, Lord! No such thing shall ever happen to you." He turned and said to Peter, "Get behind me, Satan! You are an obstacle to me. You are thinking not as God does, but as human beings do." Then Jesus said to his disciples, "Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me. For whoever wishes to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake will find it. What profit would there be for one to gain the whole world and forfeit his life? Or what can one give in exchange for his life? For the Son of Man will come with his angels in his Father's glory, and then he will repay all according to his conduct." [Matthew 16:21-27]

Guidelines for attending Mass

- No social gathering before OR after Mass inside the Church
- A facial mask while in the Church is strongly encouraged
- Communion "in the hand" recommended
- Continuation of the 6-foot social distance rule
- Collection baskets will be located near both doors
- Use hand sanitizer before entering the Church and upon leaving
- Stay home if you are ill or have any medical issues
- No non-liturgical meetings in excess of 50 people

A Sacred Space at Home

The Coronavirus Pandemic has changed our lives in so many ways. If you're unable to attend mass and need a refuge from stress, and desire an environment conducive for prayer—consider revisiting an old Catholic tradition of making a sacred space in your home for prayer and reflection:

- Find a quiet corner/spot in your home
- Add a small table to serve as an altar
- Choose a Crucifix & a statue of the Blessed Virgin Mary
- Lay a family Bible, a prayer book, a candle and Rosary Beads on your altar
- Spend some time with the Lord alone or with family.
