Solemnity of the Blessed Virgin Mary, the Mother of God January 1st

The Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God, is celebrated on Tuesday, January 1st, a Holy Day of Obligation. Masses will be celebrated as follows:

Monday, December 31st 4:00 PM [English]
 Tuesday, January 1st 8:30 AM [Latin]
 10:30 AM [English]

Paragraphs 2180 and 2181 of the Catechism of the Catholic Church discuss holy days of obligation.

2180 ... On Sundays and other holy days of obligation the faithful are bound to participate in the Mass. The precept of participating in the Mass is satisfied by assistance at a Mass which is celebrated anywhere in a Catholic rite either on the holy day or on the evening of the preceding day.

2181 The Sunday Eucharist is the foundation and confirmation of all Christian practice. For this reason the faithful are obliged to participate in the Eucharist on days of obligation, unless excused for a serious reason (for example, illness, the care of infants) or dispensed by their own pastor. Those who deliberately fail in this obligation commit a grave sin.
