### SANCTUARY CANDLE DEDICATION: CHRIST IS THE LIGHT OF THE WORLD

Candles are used in worship as a reminder of Christ our light and the light in us that is His grace. They are also a symbol of His sacrifice. As the candle burns, it sacrifices itself in order to give light. When we light a candle, we make an offering for a particular intention. The candles that burn before the Blessed Sacrament in red globes are offerings to God for particular intentions.

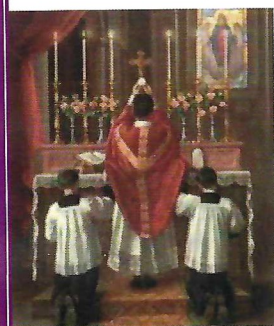

**Graven Images: The Audacity of Christian Art in Light of the Incarnation**

Join us from 9-10 a.m. Sunday, February 26 and March 5 as we begin a study of Christian Art and its impact on our Catholic tradition and heritage. How can we better understand and appreciate the audacity of Christian art when the Hebrew tradition seemingly forbids the use of images? What role does the Incarnation of Christ play in all this?
